3847. SHRIMATI BUTTARENUKA:

Will the Minister of DRINKING WATER AND SANITATION be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of villages in KurnoolDistrict of Andhra Pradesh wheresafe drinking water is not availableas yet;
- (b) whether the Governmentproposes to increase the funding for theprojects being taken up under the NationalRural Drinking Water Programme(NRDWP) in Kurnool District of the Stateof Andhra Pradesh;
- (c) whether any plan has beenprepared for providing safe drinking waterto all villages in the Kurnool District of Andhra Pradesh; and
- (d) if so, the time by which the task is expected to be accomplished?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR DRINKING WATER AND SANITATION (SHRI RAMESH CHANDAPPA JIGAJINAGI)

(a) to (d), The population in 18 rural habitations in Kurnool district is at the risk of consuming contaminated water. Although drinking water is state subject, Ministry of Drinking Water & Sanitation supplements the efforts of the State Governments for improving coverage of rural drinking water supply by providing technical & financial assistance through Centrally Sponsored National Rural Drinking Water Programme (NRDWP) as per the pre-approved allocation criteria. As reported by State Government of Andhra Pradesh, sanctions have been accorded for 9 villages out of 18 for an amount of Rs. 761.50 Lakhs under NRDWP and National Bank for Agriculture and Rural Development (NABARD)programmes. Further 4 villages have been covered through CWPP funded by NITI Aayog. The balance 5 villages are also being planned to cover through schemes and CWPP. The State Government has decided to provide safe drinking water to all habitations with 70 litres per capita per day (lpcd) service level with 100% household connections for all habitations on annuity mode and banks assistance in the State of Andhra Pradesh. Accordingly Andhra Pradesh Drinking Water Supply Corporation has been formed. The survey & preparation of entire Detailed Project Reports (DPR) for Kurnool district are under process, execution of which is planned to be completed by 2022.
