Piped Water Supply

†3853. SHRI HARI MANJHI: SHRI RAJENDRAAGRAWAL:

Will the Minister of DRINKING WATER AND SANITATION be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has identified the areas with scarcity of drinkingwater and if so, the details thereof, State-wise;
- (b) the steps taken by the Government to manage the scarcity of drinking water in these areas;
- (c) the State-wise number of households in which piped drinking water is supplied by the Government, State/UT-wise;
- (d) the percentage of people as well as the number of households which are likely to be included under the same;
- (e) the total amount of funds allocated/released and spent under the said scheme during each of the last three years and the current year and the State-wise amount of funds likely to be spent for achieving the target of providing drinking water through pipes; and
- (f) the time by which drinking water is likely to be supplied through pipes to all the households in all the villages?

ANSWER MINISTER OF STATE FOR DRINKING WATER AND SANITATION (SHRI RAMESH CHANDAPPA JIGAJINAGI)

(a)& (b) Identification of water scarce areas is done by the State itself. As per the information furnished by the States on Integrated Management Information System (IMIS) of the Ministry, 16.87% of total rural population is being provided less than the norm of 40 litres per capita per day (lpcd) and 3.65 % of rural population is at the risk of consuming contaminated water. Thus about 20.52 % of rural population is getting less than 40 lpcd safe drinking water whereas the need for drinking & cooking is 8-10 lpcd. Rural drinking water supply is a state subject. The responsibility of implementation and execution of various water supply schemes under the programme lies with the State. Under National Rural Drinking Water Programme (NRDWP), this Ministry provides technical & financial assistance to states to improve the coverage of safe drinking water in rural areas. There is also direct funding of substantial amount to

- rural local bodies for various basic services including water supply. To supplementfurther, the States have been advised to pool more funds from external assistance or loan from lending institutions.
- (c) & (d) As reported by the State Governments on online Integrated Management Information System (IMIS) of the Ministry, the State wise number of households in which piped drinking water is supplied by the Government under NRDWP as on 06.08.2018 is at Annexure-I.State governments with the assistance from various agencies including Government of India are taking up schemes for gradually improving this coverage further.
- (e) & (f) The State wise details of funds allocated, released and utilized under NRDWP during last three years and current year is at Annexure-II. Further, this Ministry is likely to get Rs. 10,000 Crore for 2019-20 for providing piped water supply. Providing drinking water supply is a dynamic process.
