3870. SHRI NAGESH GODAM:

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS

be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the National Highway No. 44 (old 7) four lane road work was completed in the year 2010;
- (b) if so, the working agencies pertaining to packages AP-6, AP-7 and AP-8 were handed over the work in complete shape; and
- (c) whether the Government proposes sliproads, service roads, side lightings and central lightings in said packages?

ANSWER

- (a) The work for 4-laning of Nagpur-Hyderabad and Hyderabad-Bangalore road stretch of NH-44 (old NH-7) in the States of Telangana and Andhra Pradesh was completed in 2010. However, the work on Armoor-Adloor Yellareddy section on Nagpur-Hyderabad road stretch of NH-44 was completed in the year 2013.
- (b) The work for 4-laning of AP-6 (i.e. Andhra Pradesh /Maharashtra Border to Islam Nagar), AP-7 (i.e. Islam Nagar to Kadthal) and AP-8 (Kadthal to Armoor) packages were taken up under BOT (Annuity) mode with a concession period of 20 Years. Presently, these stretches are under Operation & Maintenance (O&M) stage with respective concessionaires till the end of concession period.
- (c) Slip roads, service roads and lightings have been provided in the above packages as per the provision of respective concession agreements.
