- (a) & (b): National Textile Corporation Limited (NTC) has revived its 23 Mills under Board for Industrial and Financial Reconstruction (BIFR) approved Modified revivalScheme-2008(MS-08) including set up of 3 Green fields Mills in the year 2009-10. NTC has closed 78 unviable mills for the closure of mills under Industrial Dispute Act (ID Act), there is no mandate for their revival.
- (c) & (d): NTC has revived 5 Mills in Maharashtra under MS-08 including one green field milli.e. Finlay Mills, Achalpur. There is no fresh proposal to revive closed mills in Maharashtra.
- (e) & (f): There are no existing employees in the closed mills. Therefore, no resettlement schemeis proposed for closed mills.
