(a) whether the Government has received reports of disregard of road design and road signage on expressways, particularly in the recently constructed Delhi-Meerut Expressway cum Highway and Eastern Peripheral Expressway giving rise to an increased in the probability of accidents;

(b) if so, the details thereof;

(c) the number of accidents that have taken place thereon so far; and

(d) whether the Government has prepared any effective mechanism to correct the mistakes and prevent accidents, if so, the details thereof?

(a) to (b) No, Madam. The Government has not received any reports of disregard of road design and road signage on recently constructed Delhi-Meerut Expressway cum Highway and Eastern Peripheral Expressway giving rise to an increase in the probability of accidents.

(c) The number of accidents that have taken place on Delhi-Meerut Expressway cum Highway and Eastern Peripheral Expressway is not available separately. However, total no. of accidents State wise is placed at **Annexure I to Annexure III**.

(d) In order to prevent accidents, Route petrol has been deployed at every 20 Km length of EPE and installation of CCTV cameras will also be done on the Expressway.
