SCRAPPING OF OLD VEHICLES

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS

be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government is considering to come out with a policy to scrap 15 years old vehicles in the country as a measure to reduce pollution;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether a 15 year old vehicle which meets non-polluting standard will also be scrapped, if so, the reasons therefor;
- (d) whether the Government will provide some incentive to the owners for scrapping their old vehicles, if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) whether this policy will be implemented only in Metro cities, where pollution is very high or throughout the country, if so, the details thereof?
