3980. SHRIMATI RAKSHATAI KHADSE:

Will the Minister of ENVIRONMENT, FOREST AND CLIMATE CHANGE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has received a joint investigation report by the Central Drugs Standards Control Organization and the Drug Inspector of Drugs Control Department regarding procurement of some scheduled drugs by the zoo authority without having the license from the concerned authority and the subsequent missing of these drugs;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the action taken/proposed to be taken by the Government in this regards?
