- (a) whether the 'Rogi Kalyan Samitis' (Patient Welfare Committees) are working under National Rural Health Mission across the country and if so, the details thereof, State/UT-wise including Rajasthan;
- (b) whether any funds have been allocated under this scheme to Rajasthan during the last five years; and
- (c) if so, the details thereof?

(a): The Framework for Implementation of National Rural Health Mission subsumed under National Health Mission (NHM) provides for constitution of Hospital Development Committee/Rogi Kalyan Samiti/ Patient Welfare Committee at District Hospitals, Community Health Centres and Primary Health Centres. The State/ UT wise information on registered Rogi Kalyan Samiti/ Patient Welfare Committee including Rajasthan as on March, 2018 is at Annexure.

(b) & (c) Untied Funds including Annual Maintenance Grants and Corpus Grants to Rogi Kalyan Samiti/ Patient Welfare Committee provided to Rajasthan under NHM for the Financial years 2013-14 to 2017-18 is as below:
