#### **Plantation Drive**

## 4099. SHRI SANTOSH KUMAR: SHRI HARI OM PANDAY: SHRI RAJESH KUMAR DIWAKER:

Will the Minister of ENVIRONMENT, FOREST AND CLIMATE CHANGE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has undertaken or proposes to launch any plantation drive across the country including Hathras region of Uttar Pradesh to increase green cover;
- (b) if so, the State/UT-wise details thereof along with the target fixed for plantation of trees by the year 2021;
- (c) the details of mechanism, procedure and implementing agencies in Uttar Pradesh for the same;
- (d) the increase in green cover, if any, noticed in the said region due to plantation drive during the last three years and the current year;
- (e) whether any activists/social organizations are involved in the process and if so, the details thereof; and
- (f) the steps taken/to be taken by the Government to increase further green cover and promote forest based economy in the country especially in the said region?

#### **ANSWER**

### MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF ENVIRONMENT, FOREST AND CLIMATE CHANGE (DR. MAHESH SHARMA)

- (a) and (b) Afforestation activities are being undertaken in forest as well as non-forest areas under various programs like Green India Mission, National Afforestation Programme, and Compensatory Afforestation Fund Management and Planning Authority of Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change (MoEF&CC) and other programs of other ministries. The Uttar Pradesh Forest Department has proposed to undertake plantation drive including Hathras region of Uttar Pradesh to increase green cover. The afforestation activities are being carried out in accordance with Annual Plans of Operation of States for each year. The State/UT-wise details of afforestation under above said programs are **annexed**.
- (c) to (e) The Uttar Pradesh Forest Department is a nodal agency for carrying out the afforestation/plantation activities in the State with active participation of local communities. The forest and tree cover in Uttar Pradesh as per the India State of Forest Report (ISFR), 2017 shows an increase of 877 sq. km compared to the forest and tree

cover as reported in ISFR, 2013. However, forest cover (23 sq. km) in Hathras region does not show any change for the period 2013-2017.

(f) All the above schemes and programs will increase green cover and promote forest based economy in the country. The Uttar Pradesh Forest Department is also implementing various schemes like Social Forestry, Social forestry in urban areas, Green belt development scheme, Total Forest Cover scheme and Forest Cover Enrichment Scheme to increase green cover.
