SHRI PRATHAP SIMHA:

Will the Minister of WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government is implementing the Scheme for Adolescent Girls (SAG) to provide nutrition, support and vocational/skill training;
- (b) if so, the salient features thereof, including guidelines issued to States; thereunder;
- (c) the physical and financial progress of the scheme;
- (d) the funds allocated, released and utilised there under during each of the last three years and the current year, State/UT-wise;
- (e) the details of beneficiaries under the scheme during the said period, State/ UT-wise; and
- (f) whether the scheme has been extended to 303 districts in addition to existing 205 districts across the country and if so, the details thereof, State/UT-wise?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT

(a) to (b): Yes Madam, the Government is implementing , Scheme for Adolescent Girls, a Centrally-sponsored scheme, to provide nutrition support for out of school adolescent girls (11-14 years). In addition, the scheme aims at motivating out of school girls in the age group of 11-14 years to go back to formal schooling or skill training under non-nutrition component of the scheme. The Scheme aims at all-round development of out-of-school Adolescent Girls of age 11-14 years and is implemented through the State Governments/UTs using ICDS infrastructure.

The scheme has two components Nutrition and Non Nutrition. Under the Nutrition component, each out of school Adolescent Girl of age 11-14 years is provided 600 calories, 18-20 grams of protein and micronutrients @ Rs. 9.5 per beneficiary per day for 300 days in a year. The non-nutrition component has an built-in factor to motivate out of school girls to go back to formal schooling or skill training. In addition, the scheme also aims at promoting awareness about health, hygiene, nutrition and facilitating access to learning about public services through various interventions such as guidance and counselling as well as skill training. The guidelines of the Scheme are available on the website of MWCD.

(c): A sum of Rs. 460 crore was allocated for the scheme for 2017-18 against which a sum of Rs. 450.66 were released to States/UTs benefitting 7.26 lakh out of school adolescent girls of age 11-14 years as reported by the States/UTs. In 2018-19, against the allocation of Rs. 500 crore, as of now a sum of Rs. 81.59 crore has been released to States/UTs.

(d) State-wise funds released and utilized during each of last three years and the current year is given in **Annexure- 1**.

(e): State-wise beneficiaries covered under SAG during each of last three years and the current year target as intimated as of now by States for 2018-19 is given in **Annexure – 2**.

(f) The scheme was extended to additional 303 districts in 2017-18. The list of the State/UT-wise 303 districts covered in 2017-18 is at **Annexure-3**.
