(a) & (b): Admission to medical / dental courses is made on the basis of marks obtained in National Eligibility cum Entrance Test (NEET) followed by a Common Counselling conducted by the Directorate General of Health Services, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare and State / UT Governments. No data on the admission of number of urban and rural students into Government and private medical colleges is maintained centrally.
