HALT AT SWAROOPGANJ IN SIROHI

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Government is considering to provide a halt at Swaroopganj in Sirohi district of small distance express train intercity Ajmer-Ahmedabad-Ajmer (19411/19412), which was started on 22 April, 2013 as there are around 100 villages having a population of 25,000 people and the means of road transport are very expensive and inconvenient; and

(b) if so, the time by which it is likely to be provided and if not, the reasons therefor?

(a) & (b) No, Madam. Stoppage of 19411/19412 Ahmedabad-Ajmer Intercity Express (Daily) at Swarupganj is not feasible, at present, due to operational constraints. Besides, there is no commercial justification for the same.
