- (a) and (b): The Ministry of Tourism launched the Swadesh Darshan Scheme in the year 2014-15 for Integrated Development of Theme-Based Tourist Circuits in the country. Coastal circuit is one of the fifteen thematic circuits identified for development under the scheme. The list of projects sanctioned under the Coastal Circuit theme of Swadesh Darshan Scheme is given at the Annexure.
- (c) and (d): All states and Union Territories (UTs) having coastline including Andhra Pradesh are covered under the Coastal circuit theme. The projects under the scheme are identified for development in consultation with the State Governments/UT Administrations and are sanctioned subject to availability of funds, submission of suitable detailed project reports, adherence to scheme guidelines and utilization of funds released earlier.
