- (a) whether the Government has any proposal to decontrol urea;
- (b) if so, the details thereof along with the time by which it is likely to be done;
- (c) whether strengthening of infrastructure is required at the existing fertilizer rake points in Madhya Pradesh; and
- (d) if so, the details of the steps taken in this regard?

(a) & (b): No, Madam. There is no such proposal.

(c) & (d): Creation, strengthening, development and up-gradation of rake points is an ongoing activity of the Indian Railways. Rake points are meant for all commodities including Fertilizers. Adequate supply of Fertilizers is ensured throughout the country including Madhya Pradesh with the existing rake points.
