(a) and (b): Yes sir, in recent past, Rs. 90,000 crore was allocated in the UnionBudget and infused in various PSBs by the Government during financial year (FY) 2017-18. In the budget estimates of FY 2018-19, Rs. 65,000 crore has been allocated for recapitalisation of PSBs and an amount of Rs. 51,533 crore has been infused in PSBs till 31.12.2018 PSBs-wise details of capital infusion by Government in PSBs in FY 2017-18 and up to 31.12.2018 in FY 2018-19 are at Annex.

India InfrastructureFinancialCompanyLimited(IIFCL) is the only CentralPublicSector Enterprise under the administrativecontrol of the Department of FinancialServices. An amount of Rs. 100 crore each in FY 2017-18 and FY 2018-19 was allocated in the Unior Budget and infused in IIFCL by the Government.
