# STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY OF THELOK SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO. 75 ASKED BY SHRI BHARAT SINGH FOR ANSWER ON DECEMBER 14, 2018

- (a) Yes Madam. 90 videoscopes were procured by CBIC in 2017, in the first phase. Further, order for another 74 videoscopes has been placed in November, 2018, in the second phase.
- (b) Videoscope is an inspection tool which enables Customs officers to view inaccessible areas during examination of goods/vessels/aircraft and thereby assist in detection of concealed contraband. Detection of contraband including gold etc results in safeguarding the revenue and prevention of smuggling.
- (c) Does not arise in view of (b) above.
