**BS-VI EMISSION NORMS**

1616. SHRI RAJESHBHAI CHUDASAMA:

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS

be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government will be ready with Bharat Stage (BS)-VI emission norms for petrol and diesel vehicles by the end of 2018;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Government has formulated any schedule to make available BS-VI compliant vehicles in NCR and other metropolitan cities of the country suffering from the problem of pollution; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

**ANSWER**

(a) to (d) The Government vide G.S.R. 889(E), dated 16.09.2016 has mandated mass emission standard for BS-VI throughout the country with effect from 1<sup>st</sup> April 2020. Further, Hon'ble Supreme Court vide its order dated 24<sup>th</sup> October, 2018 has directed that no new motor vehicle conforming to the emission standard Bharat Stage-IV shall be sold or registered in the entire country with effect from 01.04.2020.
