(a) & (b): Yes, Madam. For expansion / development of Coimbatore Airport, Airports Authority of India (AAI) has projected a requirement of 468 acres of land to the State Government of Tamil Nadu, of which 365 acres of land required for construction of new Integrated Terminal Building Complex, Cargo facilities, additional 7 aprons for parking of Category-C type of aircraft, Parallel Taxi Track, etc. in the first phase and the remaining land for extension of Runway for operation of Code E type of Aircraft in the second phase.
