(a) As per information received from police department of all States/UTs the total number of road accidents occurred during the night time in the country during the last five calendar years i.e 2013 to 2017 are given in the table below:-

The percentage share of accidents taking place during night time (18.00 hrs to 6.00 hrs) accounts for approximately 40 percent.
