(a) the present status of Rupsi Airport in Dhubri, Assam to be re-opened for civil and army flight operations;

(b) whether the Government has included Rupsi Airport in UDAN sewa;

(c) if so, the details thereof along with details of the fund allocated for it; and (d) the reasons for delay and by when this airport will be ready for operation?

(a): Airports Authority of India (AAI) has initiated the work for construction of Terminal Building and Strengthening & Re-carpeting of Runway at Rupsi Airport in Dhubri, Assam.

(b) & (c): Yes, Madam. The route Guwahati-Rupsi-Guwahati has been awarded to M/s Turbo Megha Airways Private Ltd. under Regional Connectivity Scheme (RCS) - UDAN and an amount of Rs. 71.63 Crores has been allocated under the scheme for development of the airport.

(d): There is no delay and the probable date for the operationalisation of the airport is in September, 2019.
