- (a) to (c): Yes, Madam. Non-vegetarian meals have been discontinued in the Economy Class of Domestic Sector flights with effect from 20th June, 2017 to save costs, reduce wastage, improve service and also avoid any chances of mix up of meals. The expected annual saving is Rs.8-10 crore per annum.
