(a) Yes Madam, in the case of an applicant, having mother as a 'single parent', the necessity of furnishing father's name, in permanent account number (PAN) Forms have been relaxed. Vide Notification bearing G.S.R. No.1128 (E) dated 19th November, 2018, the application Forms for allotment of permanent number (PAN) have been amended so that an applicant, having mother as a 'single parent', may apply for PAN by furnishing mother's name only.
