- (a) whether the National Manufacturing Competitiveness Programme (NMCP) is being implemented in the country including Maharashtra; and
- (b) if so, the details thereof including the current actual expenditure incurred and achievements in all six components of NMCP during the last five years in Maharashtra?

(a)&(b): Yes, Madam. The Ministry of Micro, Small & Medium Enterprises (MSME) implemented National Manufacturing Competitiveness Programme (NMCP) till 31.03.2018 with the following components:

- (i) Lean Manufacturing Competitiveness Scheme (Lean),
- (ii) Design Clinic Scheme (Design),
- (iii) Financial Support to MSMEs in ZED Certification Scheme (ZED),
- (iv) Support for Entrepreneurial and Managerial Development of SMEs through Incubators,
- (v) Building Awareness on Intellectual Property Rights (IPR),
- (vi) Digital MSME Scheme.

During last five years including current financial year an expenditure of Rs. 12.60 crore has been made on implementation of the above programme in the State of Maharashtra.
