TRAINING IN EDUCATION AND INCOME SCHEME

2104. SHRI OM BIRLA:

Will the Minister of LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of people trained in the education and income schemes introduced for the minority society in the country during the last four years, State/UT wise and year wise;**
- (b) the details of the training centres opened for such training State/UT wise;**
- (c) the details and the number of the trained people provided employment therefrom State/UT wise?**

ANSWER

(a) to (c): The Government of India has implemented various schemes/programmes for social, economic and educational empowerment of the six (6) centrally notified minority communities namely, Muslims, Christians, Sikhs, Buddhists, Parsis and Jains. Schemes/programmes relating to education and income in brief are as under:-

(1) Pre-Matric Scholarship Scheme, Post-Matric Scholarship Scheme, Merit-cum-Means based Scholarship Scheme - For educational empowerment of students.

(2) Maulana Azad National Fellowship Scheme - Provide fellowships in the form of financial assistance.

(3) Naya Savera - Free Coaching and Allied Scheme - To enhance skill and knowledge of students and candidates for employment through competitive examinations and admission in technical and professional courses.

(4) Padho Pardesh - Scheme of interest subsidy on educational loans for overseas studies.

- (5) Nai Udaan - Support for students clearing Prelims conducted by UPSC, SSC, State Public Service Commission (PSC) etc.**
- (6) Nai Roshni - Leadership development of minority women.**
- (7) Seekho Aur Kamao - Skill development scheme for youth from 14 - 35 years of age and aims to improve employability of existing workers, school dropouts etc.**
- (8) USTTAD (Upgrading the Skills and Training in Traditional Arts/Crafts for Development)**
- (9) Nai Manzil - A scheme for formal school education & skilling of school dropouts.**
- (10) PradhanMantri Jan Vikas Karyakram (PMJVK) earlier known as Multi-sectoral Development Programme (MsDP) - Implemented in identified Minority Concentration Areas for creation of assets in education, skill and health sectors.**
- (11) Grants-in-Aid to Maulana Azad Education Foundation (MAEF) for implementation of education and skill related schemes:-**
- (a) Grants-in-Aid to NGOs/Trust/Society**
- (b) Begum Hazrat Mahal National Scholarship for Meritorious Girls belonging to the Minorities.**
- (c) Gharib Nawaz Skill Development Training for providing short-term job oriented skill development courses to youth belonging to minority communities.**
- (12) Equity to National Minorities Development and Finance Corporation (NMDFC) for providing concessional loans to minorities for self-employment and income generating ventures.**

The Number of people trained in the Education Schemes & Skill Development Schemes and details of training centres opened for training of minorities and number of people trained provided employment State-wise/UT-wise is given at Annexure - I.

Government of India launched the "Nai Manzil" Scheme on 8th Aug 2015 and rolled out in FY 2016-17, It is a comprehensive education and skill development scheme implemented by the Ministry of Minority Affairs (MoMA) for the minority youth aged between 17 to 35 years. Placement phase of Nai Manzil Scheme is yet to be started.
