Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that the Government had taken a decision to set up Kendriya Vidyalayas in each Constituency/ district of the country and if so, the details thereof including the details of districts having no Kendriya Vidyalayas till date throughout the country;
- (b) the number of districts in Tamil Nadu where KV have not been set up so far along with the total number of KVs functioning in Andhra Pradesh, District wise; and
- (c) whether the Government is considering to open two more KVs in Rajahmundry, East Godavari District in Andhra Pradesh and if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

**MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT
(DR. SATYA PAL SINGH)**

(a) The Kendriya Vidyalayas (KVs) are opened primarily to cater to the educational needs of the children of transferable Central Government employees including Defence and Para-Military personnel by providing a common programme of education. Proposals for opening of new KVs are considered only if sponsored by Ministries or Departments of the Government of India/State Governments/ Union Territories Administrations thereby committing resources for setting up a new KV as well as the availability of necessary sanction of the Government.

No such decision has been taken by the Government so far for setting up KVs in each constituency/district of the country. However, at present 148 districts in the country do not have KVs. The details are at **Annexure-I**.

(b) At present, 13 districts of Tamil Nadu do not have KVs. There are 33 KVs in the State of Andhra Pradesh. The district-wise details are at **Annexure-II**.

(c) No such proposal is under consideration of the Government at present.
