- (a) The Project Approval Board for Scheme for Infrastructure Development in Minority Institutes (IDMI) in its meeting held on 26.09.2018 has given in-principle approval of Rs 33.99 crore for the year 2018-19. Funds under the scheme are released based on the complete proposals received from the Minority Institutes through the respective States/UTs. No funds have been released under the scheme for the financial year 2018-19, so far.
- (b) The National Curriculum Framework, 2005, recommendational sinclusive education for children with special needs. Hence, no additional funds are disbursed for the school exclusively set up for special needs of children by the Ministry of Human Resource Development.
