(a) the objectives and status of implementation of Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana;

(b) whether the Government is considering to make amendments in the targets set under the said scheme; and

(c) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP (SHRI ANANTKUMAR HEGDE)

(a) Under Skill India Mission, Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship through National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC) is implementing a flagship scheme Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY) 2016-20 with an objective to provide skilling / upskilling to 1 crore (60 lakh under Short Term Training (STT) and 40 lakh under Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL)) prospective youth pan India for four years with a budgetary outlay of Rs. 12,000 Crore.

As on 30.11.2018, under the PMKVY 2016-20 scheme, 33.93 lakh (appx.) candidates have been trained under STT (24.13 lakh), RPL (9.08 lakh) and Special Project (0.72 lakh) across the country in various sectors.

(b) and (c) No Madam, as on date, there is no such plan to consider the amendment of target fixed under PMKVY 2016-20.
