CREATION OF EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITIES

2229. SHRI ASHOK MAHADEORAO NETE:

Will the Minister of LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the total number of employment opportunities created in the organised and unorganised sectors of the country as on date;**
- (b) the number of people provided employment in the organised and unorganised sectors of the country during the last three years and the current year, State/UT-wise;**
- (c) the percentage of unemployed male and female in urban and rural areas of the country; and**
- (d) the steps being taken or proposed to be taken by the Government for the security and welfare of the workers engaged in the unorganised sector?**

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE (IC) FOR LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT

(a) & (b): Employment generation coupled with improving employability is the priority of the Government. The Government is implementing various programs in this direction like encouraging private sector of economy, fast tracking various projects involving substantial investment and increasing public expenditure on schemes like Prime Minister's Employment Generation Programme (PMEGP), Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme (MGNREGS), Pt. Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Grameen Kaushalya Yojana (DDU-GKY) and Deendayal Antodaya Yojana-National Urban Livelihoods Mission (DAY-NULM). The details of employment generated through these schemes are placed at Annexure I, II, III and IV.

(c): Labour Bureau, Ministry of Labour and Employment has conducted employment-unemployment surveys in 2015-16. As per the survey results, the findings are as given below:

(d): The Government has enacted to provide social security benefits to the workers in the unorganised sector, the Unorganised Workers' Social Security Act, 2008 to provide welfare schemes in matters relating to (a) life and disability cover (b) health and maternity benefits (c) old age protection and (d) any other benefits to the unorganised workers. Various Ministries/Departments of the Central Government are implementing such social security schemes like Indira Gandhi National Old Age Pension Scheme (Ministry of Rural Development); National Family Benefit Scheme (Ministry of Rural Development); health and maternity schemes (Ministry of Health and Family Welfare). The Central Government has also converged the social security scheme of Aam Aadmi Bima Yojana (AABY) with Pradhan Mantri Jeevan Jyoti Bima Yojana (PMJJBY) and Pradhan Mantri Suraksha Bima Yojana (PMSBY) to provide life and disability coverage to the unorganised workers depending upon their eligibility. Government has recently launched Ayushman Bharat – National Health Protection Mission (AB-NHPM) during the year 2018-19 to cover over 10 crore poor and vulnerable families (approx.. 50 crore beneficiaries) based on deprivation and occupational criteria.
