(c) & (d) These schemes ensure inclusive and equitable quality education in accordance with the Sustainable Development Goal (SDG) for Education. The Samagra Shiksha (launched in the year 2018-19) is an Integrated Scheme for School Education which subsumes the three erstwhile Centrally Sponsored Schemes of Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan (SSA), Rashtriya Madhyamik Shiksha Abhiyan (RMSA), and Teacher Education (TE). Similarly, the schemes Natioanal Meanscum Merit Scholarship Scheme (NMMSS) and National Scheme of Incentive to Girls for Secondary Education (NSIGSE) are boarded on National Scholarship Portal (NSP) since 2015, which is a single scholarship portal developed for streamlining and fast tracking the delivery of scholarship across all Ministries/ Departments of Government of India.

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
