- (a) the present status of both the freight corridors;
- (b) the estimated cost of both the freight corridors along with their estimated present cost;
- (c) the amount spent so far on both the said corridors; and
- (d) the time by which the said projects are likely to be completed?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI RAJEN GOHAIN)

(a): For both the Western Dedicated Freight Corridor (WDFC) and Eastern Dedicated Freight Corridor (EDFC), all contracts have been awarded except for system contracts for Khurja-Dadri and Khurja-Ludhiana sections of EDFC.

The physical and financial progress of both the corridors as on November, 2018 is:

Physical progress	53.7%
Financial progress	51.5%

- (b): The revised estimated cost sanctioned by Government for both EDFC and WDFC in 2015 is ₹ 81,459 Crore.
- (c): Total Expenditure incurred as on 30.11.2018 is $\stackrel{>}{\sim}$ 42,751/- crores approximately.
- (d): Both Western Dedicated Freight Corridor and Eastern Dedicated Freight Corridor are targeted to be completed in phases by the year 2020.
