(d): Arising and filling up of vacancies is a continuous process. Since 2014, a total of 13 Centralized Employment Notifications (CENs) have been issued by Railway Recruitment Boards (RRBs). The details are as under:-

(e): To expedite the recruitment process, RRBs have adopted and implemented initiatives of 'Online Applications' and 'Computer Based Tests (CBTs)' in recruitment for Group 'C' & 'D' posts on Indian Railways. Recruitments against all the three CENs of 2015, have been successfully conducted in CBT mode and have since been completed. Further, in the ongoing mega recruitments against CENs No. 01/2018 for about 47.56 lakh applicants and 02/2018 for about 1.89 crore applicants, 1st stage CBT has also been conducted during 09.08.2018 to 17.12.2018 in multiple shifts.
