STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) TO (c) OF UNSTARRED QUESTION NO. 2435 BY SHRI NIHAL CHAND TO BE ANSWERED IN LOK SABHA ON 26.12.2018 REGARDING WORLD CLASS RAILWAY STATIONS

(a) and (b): Government has recently approved Railways' proposal for redevelopment of railway stations by Indian Railway Stations Development Corporation Limited (IRSDC) as Nodal Agency, through simplified procedures and for longer lease tenure. Accordingly, all the stations on Indian Railways, located in various States and Union Territories of the country, have been entrusted to IRSDC for undertaking the techno-economic feasibility studies. Based on the outcome of the feasibility studies, the stations are planned to be taken up for redevelopment in phases. Presently, work of redevelopment is in progress at Gandhinagar and Habibganj stations. Contracts have been awarded for Gomtinagar and Charbagh (Lucknow) stations.

(c) The cost of station project is to be met by leveraging commercial development of land and air space in and around the stations. Therefore, no funds are earmarked for this purpose.
