(a) whether the incidents of planes overshooting the runway has become a regular phenomenon in many airports in the country;

(b) if so, the total number of such incidents reported during the last two years;

(c) whether the Government has directed the airlines and the airport authorities to take appropriate action in the matter; and

(d) if so, the details thereof?

Runway overshooting by the airplanes operating in the country is not a regular phenomenon. However, during last 02 years a total of 07 cases of runway overshooting by airplanes occurred.

c)& d)
Based on the findings observed in the investigation report, following actions have been taken to avoid the the recurrence:

•Safety recommendations emanating from the investigation reports are followed up for implementation with the concerned agencies so as to prevent

recurrence of similar incident in the future.

•Accident/incident data is analyzed on yearly basis and based on the analysis, important observations/findings are shared with operators to avoid the

recurrence of the accidents/incidents.

•As per the annual surveillance program, audit of the operators is carried out. Findings of audit report are followed up with the operator for compliance. The compliance of the action taken by the operator is further verified during the next audit.
