### **Funding and Progress of SBM**

### †2561. SHRI NIHAL CHAND:

Will the Minister of **DRINKING WATER AND SANITATION**be pleased to state:

- (a) the funds allocated under Swachh Bharat Mission (Grameen) (SBM-G) during the last one year in the country, State/UT-wise;
- (b) whether the Government has released first installment of Central assistance for annual plan for the year 2018-19;
- (c) if not, the reasons therefor and the time by which the funds are likely to be released;
- (d) the current progress of SBM-G; and
- (e) whether the Government has issued any guidelines to the States to bring improvement therein and if so, the details thereof?

#### **ANSWER**

## MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF DRINKING WATER & SANITATION (SHRI RAMESH CHANDAPPA JIGAJINAGI)

- (a) Swachh Bharat Mission (Gramin) [SBM(G)] is a demand driven scheme, hence fixed State-wise allocation of funds is not made. However, State/UT-wise details of Centre share funds released during thelast yearare given at **Annexure**.
- (b)&(c) The 1<sup>st</sup>installment of Central assistance for annual plan for the year 2018-19 under [(SBM-G)] have been released to all the States/UTs except forfew States/UTs to which1<sup>st</sup> instalment could not be released due to non-fulfilment of some pre-requisite conditions. The same will be released on their fulfillmentby these States/UTs.
- (d) to(e) The Government had launched SBM(G) with effect from 2<sup>nd</sup> October, 2014 with the aim to attain Open Defecation Free (ODF) India by 2<sup>nd</sup> October, 2019 by providing access to toilet facilities to all rural households in the country. Under SBM(G), 899.98 lakh individual household toilets have been constructed as on 21.12.2018, and the sanitation coverage in the country, which was 38.7% as on 2<sup>nd</sup> October, 2014, has increased to 97.72%. And, 5,37,427 villages, 2,43,947 Gram Panchayats, 5776 Blocks, 569 Districts, and 25 States/UTs, have been declared ODF.
