VACANT POSTS IN DOORDARSHAN AND AAKASHWANI

2679: DR. RAMESH POKHRIYAL "NISHANK":

Will the Minister of INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of posts lying vacant in Directorate of Doordarshan and Directorate of Aakashwani as on date, State-wise;
- (b) the steps taken by the Government to fill up these vacant posts including Himalayan State of the country including Uttarakhand;
- (c) the progress made in regard to conduct Departmental Promotion Committee (DPC) for regular promotions by the Ministry; and
- (d) the time frame fixed for the same by the Ministry?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) IN THE MINISTRY OF INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING [COL RAJYAVARDHAN RATHORE (Retd.)]

- (a) State-wise number of posts lying vacant in Doordarshan and All India Radio as in December, 2016, as informed by Prasar Bharati, is enclosed at **Annexure**. Existing manpower reflects, apart from other factors, reduction in manpower requirement due to changing technology, landscape etc.
- (b) to (d) Limited recruitment has been undertaken as a special dispensation through Staff Selection Commission for critical Group 'B' & 'C' vacancies, approved by the Government, on an All India basis, including the vacancies in the Himalayan States.

Regarding regular promotions, efforts have been made to convene DPCs in accordance with the timelines fixed as per DOP&T instructions. The following DPCs have been held in Prasar Bharati recently to clear the backlog:

- Promotion to JTS of Indian Broadcasting (Engineers) Service for 11 vacancy years;
- ii. Promotion to Assistant Engineer of Sub ordinate Engineering Cadre for 9 vacancy years; and
- iii. Promotion to JTS of Indian Broadcasting (Programme) Service for 19 vacancy years.
