Willthe Ministerof FINANCEbe pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the policy of India Post PaymentBanks;
- (b) the details of the entities/companies which have been provided license for opening of payment banks;
- (c) the number of paymentbanks set up, State/UT-wise; and
- (d) the number of accounts opened during the last three years, State/UT-wise along with the details of the transaction undertakenthrough these accounts?

#### **ANSWER**

## Minister of State in the Ministry of Finance (SHRI SHIV PRATAPSHUKLA)

- (a): With regard to the details of the policy of India Post Payment Bank (IPPB), Department of Posts (DoP) has informed that IPPB has been launched with a vision to build the most accessible, affordable and trusted bank for the common man and with the intention of spearheading the financial inclusion agenda by removing barriers for the unbanked and under-banked population. IPPB leverages the vast network of DoP, which covers every corner of the country, to offer doorstep banking in rural, urban and remote areas, thus enabling IPPB to take banking to the last mile. IPPB is offering a bouquet of product and services, such as savings and current accounts, remittances and money transfer, direct benefit transfer, bill and utility payments, and enterprise and merchan payments. These products and services are being offered across multiple channels, like counter services, micro-ATM, doorstep banking, mobile banking app, short message service (SMS), etc., using cutting-edgetechnology.
- (b) to (d): State-/Union-territory-wisedetails of entities/ companies that have been provided licence for opening of payments banks, as reported by Reserve Bank of India (RBI) are at Annexure-1. As regards the number of accounts opened during the last three years and the details of transaction undertakenthrough these accounts, RBI has apprised that these are not available withit.

In respect of IPPB, as per DoP inputs, since the launch of IPPB's operations on 30.1.2017, the State-/Union-territory-wise number of accounts opened till 24.12.2018 are placed at Annexure-2, and the total number of transaction still 20.12.2018 was 9,75,806.
