Will the Minister of **AYURVEDA, YOGA AND NATUROPATHY, UNANI, SIDDHA AND HOMOEOPATHY (AYUSH)** be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of AYUSH Hospitals set up by the Government during the last two years, State-wise; and
- (b) whether there is any proposal to set up multi-speciality AYUSH hospitals in the State of Uttar Pradesh, if so the details thereof?

- (a): Public Health being a State subject. Opening of AYUSH Hospitals comes under purview of respective State/UT Governments. However, under Centrally Sponsored Scheme of National AYUSH Mission (NAM), there is provision of financial assistance for setting up of upto 50 bedded integrated AYUSH hospitals. The number of upto 50 bedded integrated AYUSH hospitals approved during the last two years State/UT-wise is furnished at **Annexure**.
- (b): There is no proposal received under NAM to set up multi-speciality AYUSH hospitals in the State of Uttar Pradesh.
