Will the Minister of AYURVEDA, YOGA AND NATUROPATHY, UNANI, SIDDHA AND HOMOEOPATHY (AYUSH) be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of Unani Centres functioning in the country under the Ministry, State/UT-wise and location-wise along with the achievements made by these centres since their inception;
- (b) the estimated number of patients getting treatment in these centres and the total amount of funds spent during each of the last three years and the current year, State/UT-wise;
- (c) whether the Government has received proposals from various States including Maharashtra and Tamil Nadu for opening of Unani medicine centres;
- (d) if so, the details thereof along with the action taken/proposed to be taken by the Government thereon during each of the last three years and the current year, State/UT-wise;
- (e) whether the Government has not been able to popularize Unani system of medicine in the country compared to other traditional medicines; and
- (f) if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefor along with the steps being taken by the Government to promote and expand the network of Unani system of medicine?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE (IC) OF THE MINISTRY OF AYURVEDA, YOGA & NATUROPATHY, UNANI, SIDDHA AND HOMOEOPATHY (SHRI SHRIPAD YESSO NAIK)

(a): Under the Ministry of AYUSH, there is one National Institute namely National Institute of Unani Medicine (NIUM), Bangalore (Karnataka) as far as CCRUM is concerned, a total of 23 institutes /Units are functioning in different parts of the country. State / UT-wise and location wise, details of the centres are attached at **Annexure** – **I**. The achievement in various programmes of the council is given in **Annexure** – **II**.

- (b): An average number of 5 lakhs patients have been treated annually in GOPD / Special OPD in these centers. In addition to it, about 2 lakhs patients have also been treated in integration of Unani medicine in NPCDCS and Swasthya Rakshan / Parikshan programme of the Council annually. The details of the expenditure during each of the last three years and the current year are given in **Annexure III.** The information in respect of NIUM, Bangalore is given in **Annexure-IV**.
- (c) & (d): Ministry has not received any proposal for opening of the Unani medicine Center from the States of Maharashtra and Tamil Nadu. However, the Council has started one Extension Research Centre at Pattiam Gram Panchayat, Kannur, Kerala during current financial year.

Under AYUSH Services component of Centrally Sponsored Scheme National AYUSH Mission (NAM), there is provision of setting up of upto 50 bedded integrated AYUSH Hospitals which may include Unani system also. However, there is no separate provision for setting up of new Unani Hospital under NAM. The status of 50 bedded integrated AYUSH Hospital approved under National AYUSH Mission (NAM) during the last three years and the current year, State/UT-wise; is furnished at **Annexure-V**

(e) & (f): Ministry is continuously taking various initiatives for popularizing the Unani system of medicine in the country by different methods e.g. providing treatment through General OPD, RCH OPD, Geriatric OPD, NCD Clinic etc. conducted by 19 Clinical Institutes / Units of the Research Council. The Council is also popularizing Unani system of medicine through Arogyas, Health Melas, Health Camps, Seminars, Conferences, workshops, Exhibitions and Annual Unani day etc., and also through Mobile Healthcare programme and School Health programme. Two specialized programmes namely, Integration of Unani Medicine in NPCDCS and Swasthya Rakshan / Parikshan Programme are also playing important role in popularizing the Unani system of medicine.

Ministry of AYUSH is implementing Centrally Sponsored Scheme of National AYUSH Mission (NAM) in the country for promotion and development of AYUSH system including Unani system. State/UT Governments may avail eligible financial assistance by projecting the same through State Annual Action Plan (SAAP) as per NAM guideline.

The Mission inter-alia makes provision for the following:-

- (i) Co-location of AYUSH facilities at Primary Health Centers (PHCs), Community Health Centers (CHCs) and Districts Hospitals (DHs) including Unani.
- (ii)Up gradation of exclusive State Government AYUSH Hospitals and Dispensaries including Unani.
- (iii) Setting up of up to 50 bedded integrated AYUSH Hospital including Unani.
- (iv) Upgradation of State Government Under-Graduate and post-Graduate Educational Institutions including Unani.
- (v) Setting up of new State Government AYUSH Educational Institutions including Unani in the State where it is not available.
