(a) the number of foreign currency smuggling cases which came to light during the last four years along with the action taken so far on the same;

(b) whether the Government is aware of foreign currency smuggling in lieu of gold bars from foreign countries;

(c) if so, the number of such cases reported during the last four years; and

(d) the action taken so far on the same along with the details thereof?

(a) The number of foreign currency smuggling cases during the last four years are as under:-

(b) As per analysis of intelligence inputs foreign currency smuggling helps payment for contraband goods, including gold that are smuggled into India.
