SHORTAGE OF SURGEONS IN AIIMS

2843. SHRI RAM CHARAN BOHRA:

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Department of Neurosurgery in AIIMS is grappling with the shortage of surgeons;

(b) if so, the details thereof;

(c) whether the waiting period for neurosurgery has reached upto 2023 due to shortage of surgeons; and

(d) if so, the necessary corrective steps taken in this regard?

ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI ASHWINI KUMAR CHOUBEY)

(a) to (d): No. The emergency cases are admitted immediately. Priority cases are admitted within 4-8 weeks, while routine cases are handled within 3-6 months.
