2913. SHRI UDAY PRATAP SINGH:

Will the Minister of ENVIRONMENT, FOREST AND CLIMATE CHANGE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether his Ministry has received proposals from the State Government of Madhya Pradesh for promoting plantation in the State through private sector, if so, the extant status of proposals received; and
- (b) whether incentive has been sought by the State Government of Madhya Pradesh to boost plantation, if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF ENVIRONMENT, FOREST AND CLIMATE CHANGE (DR. MAHESH SHARMA)

- (a) No Madam. The Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change has not received proposals from the State Government of Madhya Pradesh for promoting plantation in the State through private sector.
- (b) The State Government of Madhya Pradesh has not sought any incentive to boost plantation.
