UPGRADATION OF MEDICAL COLLEGES

2915. SHRI AJAY NISHAD:

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government of Bihar has sent any proposal for upgrading Shri Krishna Medical College Hospital, Muzaffarpur to the level of All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS);
- (b) if so, the details and the present status thereof; and
- (c) the time by which the said proposal is likely to be implemented by the Union Government?

(a) to (c): No. However, this Ministry has taken up upgradation of Shri Krishna Medical College, Muzaffarpur under Phase – III of Pradhan Mantri Swasthya Suraksha Yojana (PMSSY), at an approved outlay of Rs. 150 crore (Central Share – Rs. 120 crore and State Share – Rs. 30 Crore). The upgradation programme involves construction of a 210 bedded Super Speciality Block (SSB).
