(a) & (b) For the students belonging to the economically weaker sections, an interest subsidy scheme, namely Central Sector Interest Subsidy Scheme (CSIS), is operational under which full interest subsidy, on educational loans upto Rs 7.50 Lakh, is available during the period of moratorium on loans availed under the Model Education Loan Scheme from Scheduled Banks.
