Convocation Attire

3038. SHRIMATI VASANTHI M.: Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has appealed to Universities across the country to replace their British inspired convocation attire with traditional Indian clothes as a tribute to Mahatma Gandhi;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether many institutions of higher education introduced traditional attire for convocation ceremonies; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

(a) to (d): The University Grants Commission (UGC) has informed that it has issued a letter to the Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) requesting them to consider using handloom fabric for ceremonial dresses prescribed for special occasions like convocation etc. The letter is available on the UGC website at https://www.ugc.ac.in/pdfnews/5896148_Handloom-Fabric.pdf. Also, many universities have adopted Indian attire on their own volition.
