Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS be please to state:

- (a) the status of implementation of the National Heritage City Development and Augmentation Yojana (HRIDAY);
- (b) whether the work has been completed in all 12 heritage cities;
- (c) if so, the details thereof;
- (d) if not, the details of the cities in which work is pending and the reasons therefor; and
- (e) the time by which the pending works are likely to be completed?

(a) to (e) The National Heritage City Development and Augmentation Yojana (HRIDAY) scheme was launched on 21st January, 2015 and the mission period of the scheme is till 31st March, 2019. So far, 70 projects worth Rs.422.61 Crore have been sanctioned for the 12 heritage cities. Out of the 70 projects, 24 have been completed and the remaining projects are at various stages of implementation and one expected to be completed before March, 2019.
