- (a) to (c): No, Madam. Transfers in HAL are effected based on organizational requirements / developmental needs of the employees. Women employees in HAL are not discriminated against, including those posted in technical and medical departments.
- (d) In the last 2 years, 57 women employees have requested for transfer on various personal grounds out of which 20 were transferred. The remaining could not be transferred due to organizational constraints.

In HAL, the workmen, irrespective of men and women are employed to cater to the specific needs of the organization and accordingly manpower available in different Divisions is in conformity with the overall organizational goal and needs.

HAL is a listed Navratna company and transfer of employees within the organization is within the administrative domain of the management.
