GADAG-YALVIGI AND NANDIKOOR-MUDIGERE RAIL LINE

**3508. SHRI PRATHAP SIMHA:
KUMARI SHOBHA KARANDLAJE:**

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that the work of laying of new railway line between Gadag-Yalvigi (58 Km) and Nandikoor-Karkala-Ujire-Mudigere (136 Km) in Karnataka, has not been completed so far due to less monetary provisions in the budget;**
- (b) if so, the reaction of the Government thereto and the reasons therefor; and**
- (c) the efforts being made by the Government for the completion of laying these new railway lines by making necessary provisions for the said works?**

ANSWER

(a) to (c): Gadag-Yalvigi new line project (58 Km) has been included in the Budget 2017-18 subject to requisite clearances. Government of Karnataka has been requested to share 50% cost of this project with land free of cost.

Project for Nandikoor-Karkal-Ujire-Charmady-Mudigere new line (136 Km) is not sanctioned. Survey for this new line has been taken up.
