- (b) if so, whether the Government proposes to take any preventive measures in this regard;
- (c) if so, the details thereof along with the time by which such steps are likely to be implemented; and
- (d) if not, the reasons therefor?

(b) to (d): Service personnel and their families are regularly sensitized on the use of honey trap as a modus operandi by foreign intelligence operatives. Advisories have been issued to all concerned. Special attention is being paid to new entrants in training institutes. Simultaneously, regular counter intelligence in liaison with central agencies is being maintained to detect attempts of honey trapping.
