**CHANGE OF NAME OF HAZARIBAGH STATION**

**Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether it is a fact that Saria station under East-central railway is known as Hazaribagh Road and passengers of Hazaribagh get off at this station in confusion;**
- (b) if so, whether the railways proposes to give advise/recommendation to State Government to change the name of this station;**
- (c) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor;**
- (d) whether the Government has received any advice from any public representative/others in this regard; and**
- (e) if so, the action taken thereon?**

**(a) The civil area outside Hazaribagh Road station is known as Saria. However, no such complaint has been received regarding passengers getting off at Hazaribagh town in confusion of Hazaribagh.**

**(b) & (c): Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India, is the competent authority to approve change in the name of a Railway station on Indian Railways. It does so on the recommendation of the State Government concerned.**

**Zonal Railway implement the change of name of railway stations after Gazette notification issued by State Government after getting approval from Ministry of Home Affairs in this regard.**

**(d) & (e): Representations/requests were received in this regard and forwarded for necessary action to the concerned based on the existing guidelines.**
