- (b) if so, whether there is increase in the number of incidents of cracked railway lines during the current winter season;
- (c) if so, whether any incident in this regard has been reported in west central railway zone, Jabalpur and whether it has been rectified; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

- (a) Yes, Madam. A regular and rigorous schedule of inspection of track has been laid down at various levels. Apart from daily foot patrolling by the Keyman, Cold weather patrolling of the railway tracks is done as per provisions of relevant Manual to look out for weld/rail fractures for ensuring safety.
- (b) No, Madam. The position of rail and weld failures over the Indian Railways' network for Main Line, during the last winter season (October to December 2017) and the current winter season (October to December 2018) is as under:

(c) & (d) Yes, Madam. 16 rail fractures and 34 weld failures have been reported on West Central Railway (WCR) during the current winter season. All these defects have been rectified. Month-wise detail of rail and weld failures on WCR is as under:
